

# SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

The CVA merit scholarship program is for prospective foundation and transfer students. Awards are based on the students' artistic and academic merits as well as the overall strength of the scholarship and admissions applications.

## Deadline

- Scholarship Application Deadline: March 1, 2010
- Notification: Decisions mailed by March 15, 2010

## Criteria

- Students must be accepted as a full-time student to CVA by March 1, 2010.
- Applicants must have a minimum high school cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- All art work must be original. Work copied from published photographs, illustrations, or other copied work will not be accepted.

## Instructions

- Submit 10 examples of your best work (work submitted as part of the admissions application can be used). All entries must be submitted on a Macintosh - compatible CD.
- Request a recommendation from an Art Teacher. They should send in their recommendation separately by March 1, 2010.

## Selection Process

- Scholarship applications will be juried by a committee of CVA faculty members representing all studio disciplines within the CVA curriculum.

## Awards

- CVA Faculty Scholarship: \$1,000 (\$1,000 Faculty + \$2,000 Academic = \$3,000/year)  
Total value: \$12,000 over 4 years
- CVA President's Scholarship: \$3,500 (\$3,500 President's + \$2,000 Academic = \$5,500/year)  
Total value: \$22,000 over 4 years
- CVA Trustee's Scholarship: \$6,500 (\$6,500 Trustee's + \$2,000 Academic = \$8,500/year)  
Total value: \$34,000 over 4 years

---

All scholarships require full-time enrollment and a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA for renewal. Scholarship awards are good for four years (8 semesters) of enrollment at CVA. CVA scholarships are merit based and do not take into account financial need. In order to apply for need-based financial aid, please contact the Financial Aid Office.
